Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03 (A) (3), the Board may vote to hold an executive session for legal advice for any matter on the agenda. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03 (A) (2), the Board may vote to go into executive session for review of any information made confidential by law. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A) (1), the Board may vote to hold an executive session for certain personnel matters. The executive session will not be open to the public.
