## NOTICE FOR AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES

## GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE

ALL GRIEVANCES MUST BE MADE IN WRITING TO THE BOARD WITHIN 20 DAYS OF THE DENIAL OF THE REQUEST FOR REASONABLE ACCOMMODATION. THE BOARD HAS 30 DAYS IN WHICH TO RESPOND TO THE ALLEGATIONS ADDRESSED IN THE GRIEVANCE. IF FURTHER RESOLUTION IS REQUIRED, THE AMERICAN DISABILITIES ACT AND THE REHABILITATION ACT OF 1973 SHALL PREVAIL.
